

Current speculation is that it may be possible to hold these events once Phase 4 reopening has happened - currently slated for Aug 20 / Sep 20. More information will follow as it becomes available.

<u> District – Canceled - 102nd</u> Annual Convention




 The Annual District Kiwanis Convention has now New England & Bermuda District been CANCELED due

The six permanent Objects of Kiwanis International were approved by Kiwanis club delegates at the 1924

Kiwanis International Convention in Denver, Colorado. Through the decades, they have remained unchanged. **Object 1:** To give primacy to the human and spiritual rather than to the material values of life.

Object 2: To encourage the daily living of the Golden Rule in all human relationships.

Object 3: To promote the adoption and the application of higher social, business and professional standards.

Object 4: To develop, by precept and example, a more intelligent, aggressive and serviceable citizenship.

Object 5: To provide, through Kiwanis clubs, a practical means to form enduring friendships, to render altruistic service and to build better communities.

Object 6: To cooperate in creating and maintaining that sound public opinion and high idealism which make possible the increase of righteousness, justice, patriotism and good will.
